Champagne Cocktails - £9.00

The Classic

Created in 1862 this blend of Cognac & Champagne gets sweeter as the Angostura soaked sugar cube dissolves.

Absolutely Fabulous

In the TV show Ab Fab, Patsy consumes copious amounts of Vodka and Champagne. Here they are balanced with Cranberry Juice to give an easy drinking summery mix.

Bellini

1945, Harry's Bar, Venice. Guiseppe Cipriani combined Prosecco and White Peach Puree. The rest as they say is history.

French 75

The crisp tones of Gin and Lemon Juice add to the freshness of Champagne creating a very refreshing drink.

Chin Chin

The sweetness of Honey is used to balance Scotch Whisky in this modern Scottish twist.

Shorts - £7.50

Whiskey Sours

4 parts Spirit, 2 parts Sour, 1 part Sweet is the formula. Can be made with almost any spirit or liqueur but we recommend Scotch for obvious reasons.

Caipirinha ("Kie-Pur-Reen-Yah")

Being the national drink of Brazil means this drinks main ingredient the spirit Cachaca is actually the most consumed on the planet. It is simply mixed with fresh limes and sugar producing a very refreshing drink with a kick.

Bramble

The subtle flavours of Gin and Lemon are enhanced by a float of Creme de Mure (Blackberries).

Black Russian

The traditional recipe of Vodka and Kahlua Coffee Liqueur shaken and served over ice. Simple is often best.

Woo Woo

The Eighties didn't do much for cocktails but this mix of Vodka, Peach Schnapps and Cranberry Juice is an easy drinking crowd pleaser.

Lynchburg Lemonade

Created especially for Jack Daniels who's distillery is in Lynchburg, Tennessee. You've guessed it Real Lemonade for grownups.

Apple Breeze

Sweetness of Pressed Apple and the bitterness of Cranberry make this Vodka drink a winner on a summers day.

Zipper Head

Chambord Black Raspberry Liqueur brings an intense flavour and colour to this Vodka and Lemonade based drink.

Mojito

Care and attention is required to perfectly balance Mint, Lime, Rum and Soda. A truly sophisticated drink, the favoured tittle of Ernest Hemmingway.

Moscow Mule or Raspberry Mule

The drink that brought Vodka to the USA masses. Vodka, Lime and Ginger Beer gives this drink a spick kick. The addition of sharp Raspberries produces an excellent fruity finish.

Apricot Fizz

A fruity mix containing Apricot Liqueur, Orange Juice, Lime juice all topped off with soda.

John Collins

The fact that the creation of this drink is disputed by at least 4 countries speaks volumes about this classics popularity. A simple mix of Gin, Lemon, Sugar and soda which is dangerously easy to drink.

Ginger Grouse or Highland Park Long Serve

Even non whisky drinkers will like the Ginger Grouse. A Scottish Moscow mule containing Famous Grouse Whisky, Lime and Ginger beer. Contrary to common belief there is nothing wrong with mixing Malt Whisky so upgrade to Highland Park for a smoother taste.

Martini's - £7.50

Appletini

Pressed Apple Juice with a Vodka kick leading to a sweet Cherry at the bottom of the glass.

Cosmopolitan

A true modern classic as drunk by the stars. Vodka, Cointreau, Lime and Cranberry with a Flamed Orange.

French Martini

Black Raspberry Liqueur, Vodka and Pineapple. The original Sex in the City Drink

Strawberry Daiquiri

Strawberries have been added to the recipe devised by Jennings Cox while working the Iron Ore mines near Daiquiri, Cuba. St
